



CITY BRIEFING - 2024

'City Briefings' provide an invaluable insight into the workings of the City of London.

They are held at the Guildhall, four times a year. Presentations are typically given by an Assistant Town Clerk, the Clerk to the Chamberlain's Court, a member of the Livery Committee, and an Alderman. Together, they provide an excellent introduction to the City of London Corporation, and its relationship with the Livery Companies. There is opportunity to ask questions and the Briefing is followed by a light finger buffet.

City Briefings are aimed at new Freemen and Liverymen; their partners are also welcome. Liverymen and Freemen of longer standing, who have not previously been to a Briefing, are also encouraged to attend.
