

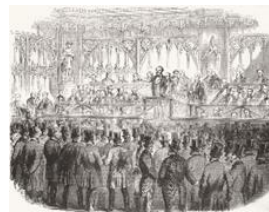


## COMMON HALL 2026

WEDNESDAY 24<sup>th</sup> JUNE and TUESDAY 29<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER

'Common Hall' is an assembly of Liverymen, held twice-yearly around Midsummer and Michaelmas, at which they elect the Lord Mayor and Sheriffs. As well as selecting those for high office in the City, Common Hall is quite a spectacle.

You are entitled to take part, as Liverymen before you have done since 1475. You can find out more from the [Livery Committee](#) or from your copy of 'The City of London Freeman's Guide'.



This year you may attend one or both gatherings of Common Hall at the Guildhall and then join fellow Tax Advisers for lunch afterwards at Founders' Hall:

- Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> June: Election of Sheriffs and Other Officers
- Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> September: Election of the Lord Mayor



Participation in Common Hall is restricted to Liverymen and, since 1725, has been further limited to those 'with one year's standing'. This year, only those who advanced before 31 May 2025 are eligible to vote.

Tickets to attend Common Hall are issued to Liverymen free of charge. Lunch at Founders' follows directly afterwards.



Freemen, spouses, and guests are not eligible to attend Common Hall; they are, however, very welcome indeed to join for Lunch afterwards.
