INSTALLATION DINNER & THANKSGIVING SERVICE

This year's Installation Dinner will be held at Mercers' Hall, preceded by a Service of Thanksgiving at St Michael's Church, Cornhill on Monday 21st September. [Dame Jayne-Anne Gadhia](#), Lead Non-Executive Director at HM Revenue and Customs, will be our guest of honour.

The Company's Day of installation consists of three successive events: a meeting of Court, when the new Master is installed; a Thanksgiving Service; and a Dinner. The Master Elect, Caroline Turnbull-Hall, and the Wardens invite all Members of the Company and their guests to attend any one or all of these, as they wish.



The Thanksgiving Service* will be held at St Michael's Church, Cornhill – originating in the 11th century, destroyed during the Great Fire, rebuilt by Wren, typical of the High Victorian manner and, more recently, 'as seen on Slow Horses'!

The Installation Dinner** will be held at Mercers' Hall, a grand venue over a former Roman temple and now in its third incarnation as a Livery Hall, two predecessors having succumbed to the Great Fire and then to the Blitz. [The Watchorns](#) will entertain after dinner with traditional Northumbrian smallpipes and fiddle.
