The Wine Estate, spanning 2,500 acres across the North Downs, has been a family home for more than three centuries and a vineyard for more than two decades. Whether the Warde’s family motto of ‘joyfulness’ results from the wine or inspired its cultivation is uncertain! Those joining in this wonderful day can look forward to:

- A tour of the vines and some history of the Estate and viticulture
- Tasting of 3 vintage wines
- A three-course seasonal lunch from Squerryes’ two AA rosette award-winning restaurant

Reaching the Estate, at Westerham, is straightforward: by train to Oxted (30-40 min from London) with onward transport provided from there, or by car to TN16 1QP (10 min off the M25, J5).

Provisional timings as follows:

- Arrival at venue 11:00am (or by 10:30am at Oxted Train Station)
- Lunch at 12:00pm
- Depart: 4:00pm



The cost is being finalised but, after a subsidy from the Master, is expected to be approximately £170 per person for the day, excluding travel.
